

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 32 (PART) PARISH OF GREAT NESS)
PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2018**

On 10th January 2019, the Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and Section 53a(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the order as confirmed is to **extinguish**

the full width of that part of Footpath 32, from point A on the order map (SJ3665 1885), running in a general westerly direction for approximately 108 metres then in a general south westerly direction for approximately 352 metres followed by a general south-south-westerly direction for approximately 141 metres to meet point B on the order map (SJ3620 1851); a total distance of approximately 601 metres.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map has been placed and may be seen free of charge at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council's website at <https://shropshire.gov.uk/outdoor-partnerships/countryside-access-and-public-rights-of-way/current-public-path-orders/>. Copies of the order and map may be bought from the Council at the above address at the price of £6.50.

The order becomes operative on 10th January 2019; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 10th January 2019 make an application to the High Court.
